COMMITTEE COMPOSITION

The composition of the EC is outlined in the <u>ET-0495A-23</u> Bylaws document (Sec. 5.7.5)

Composition: The EC comprises at least six members selected among the collaboration in order to cover a wide spectrum of expertise. Ex-officio members:

- The ET SP and DSP.
- The idea is to include a diverse range of skills (while striving for gender and geographical representation):
 - Data analyses of various kinds
 - Experimental aspects
 - Multimessenger competency and Theory facets



COMMITTEE MANDATE

 The mandate of the EC is outlined in the <u>ET-0495A-23</u> Bylaws document (Sec. 5.7.5)

Goals and tasks: The duties of the EC are:

- To manage all publications and proceedings involving the ET Collaboration and its members;
- To oversee papers led by the Collaboration or by one of its Specific Boards (EIB, ISB, OSB, and SPB); To organise internal reviews in order to meet scientific as well as editorial standards by setting up "Paper Review Committees" (PRC) which will manage circulation of such papers and collect feedback;
- To manage the author list of such Collaboration or Specific Board papers; to collect exceptional requests beyond the nominal author list.
- To recommend the approval of Collaboration or Specific Board papers to the CB and EB.
- To manage the review of conference proceedings written by Collaboration members on ET work or results.
- To manage the review of short author-list papers involving Collaboration members to ensure rules are followed. To manage the circulation of such papers and collect feedback on content and author list.
- To maintain an archive of publications accessible to all members of the Collaboration.
- To advise the CB and EB on publications and rules.
- Based on the ET OSB and ISB initial editorial rules, I would like to propose some amendments to both make the policy more comprehensive and streamline, as well as automate, the whole process

ET Publication and presentation policy proposal: My personal viewpoint


- Topics to be well addressed:
 - AUTHORSHIP for papers/presentations
 - COLLABORATION PAPERS
 - SHORT AUTHORLIST PAPERS (including conference proceedings)
 - PRESENTATIONS (including talks, posters and job interviews to some extent)
 - Master and PhD THESES
 - Proper credit to peers,
 acknowledgments to funding agencies
 and computational resources
 - Timeline often dictated by proprietary data period versus data release

- What is required:
 - Review webtool
 - <u>Database for storing papers &</u>
 <u>presentations (i.e., optimized ETDS)</u>
 - EC members and internal reviewers acting timely
 - Comprehensive and detailed guidelines

NOTE FOR SHORT AUTHORLIST PAPERS:

A policy that allows collaboration members to use (even a small percentage of) unpublished collaboration data could potentially favour/disadvantage some colleagues and may preempt collaboration plans

EXPECTED EC TIMELINE



NEXT ACTIONS

- As soon as the CB and the EB will endorse and approve, respectively, the reviewer pool I am proposing, we will have a kick-off EC meeting
- EC members will be added under the EC umbrella in the ETMD AND at the et-ssb-ec@et-gw.eu mailing list
- Initial publication and presentation policy draft expected to be ready in <~4 months after the kick-off meeting
- Regular (bi-)weekly teleconferences will be scheduled at https://wiki.et-gw.eu/SSB/EditorialCommittee

- A final draft will be provided according to a timeline that will be dicated by any potential requested amendments
- EC publication and presentation policy is expected to be fully implemented by the beginning of
 2025
