PATH TO IGWN

➤ Consensus regarding the concept of a unified organization, but there are notable concerns about the practical implementation, particularly from international partners outside the US, including LSC members from the UK, Spain, and other countries

➤ "Sensitive topics":

- Single governance. While having a unified governance offers efficiency benefits in decision-making and overall coordination, it's essential to acknowledge that IGWN will operate four detectors across three continents, each with its distinct funding and stakeholder landscape
- The concept of "Laboratory group" which is "tailored" around the LIGO lab organization and the implementation of which is not obvious in Virgo
- The different organization of scientific research in the US, Europe and Japan must be considered
- The timeline that is considered too aggressive



PATH TO IGWN

➤ Motion approved by the LSC Council:

The LSC Council extends the current LIGO-Virgo-KAGRA Memorandum of Agreement (MoA) through 31 May 2026.

After that date, any collaboration between LIGO, Virgo, and KAGRA will need to be defined by a structure substantially different from the current MoA

- > The proposed charge for the IGWN formation committee leaves ample room for negotiation
- > Funding agencies are starting to talk
 - Chat of GG with Pedro Marronetti
 - Bilateral INFN-NSF meeting
 - Presentation at GWAC meeting, end of May
 - Possibly, meeting of a "subset of GWAC" in the summer (at or after the DAWN meeting)
- ➤ My proposal/recommendation:
 - Let's accept that we have to move from the current structure of the LVK MoA
 - Let' accept the principle that going towards "IGWN" can be a positive evolution
 - Let's keep open the communication channel, and let's try to formalize "something" that goes in this direction
