### **Core Program & Committee in the Virgo Bylaws**

#### Nature of contributions to Virgo

3.2.1.1. Each Virgo group is expected to contribute significantly and in an identifiable way to scientific or technical activities essential for the success of Virgo, as defined in the Virgo core program [7] and associated documents, such as work breakdown structures and white papers.

#### **Sharing contributions**

3.2.4.1. Each Virgo group has the responsibility and obligation to share openly with the Collaboration all their research efforts within the scope of the Virgo core program. This includes hardware, hardware designs, software, analysis results, relevant data, and information about any on-going work [12].

#### > Authorship rights

■ 3.6.2. Virgo members who have made substantial contributions to the **Virgo core program** and whose time contribution is above a threshold of 0.4 SVAC (§3.2.2.3) earn the right to default authorship on all Collaboration publications. (see also 3.6.4 and 3.6.6)

#### New member groups

3.7.2. Groups interested in joining the Collaboration contact the Virgo spokesperson. Using the core program as a starting point, they develop a plan together with the spokesperson, coordinators, and other Collaboration members fore how the group will contribute to Virgo.

#### Advisory body to VSC

- 4.1.1.15. [VSC] approves MoUs with external collaborations or scientists, upon a recommendation of the core program committee (§5.0.3.1)
- 4.1.1.17. [VSC] defines and regularly updates the **core program** of Collaboration activities, upon a proposal of the **core program committee** (§5.0.3.1)
- 4.1.1.19. [VSC] approves the Collaboration publication plan, upon a proposal from the data analysis coordinator and a recommendation from the core program committee (§5.0.3.1)
- The **MoA review committee** includes a representative of the CPC (VIR-0454A-22)

## **Existing Core Program document**

- VIR-0734A-23, approved by VSC on 26 July 2023
- Divided into sections:
  - Instrument
  - Data analysis and multi-messenger
  - Instrument R&D
  - Outreach
  - Collaboration operation
- Definition of service tasks:
  - Service tasks refer to activities that go beyond the basic scientific contribution that should be expected from Collaboration members, either because of time dedication (e.g., 24/7 on-call duty, off-hours work), because they involve repetitive tasks with little scientific value in themselves, or because they involve devoting efforts toward activities external to those the individual is primarily involved in (e.g., acting as a reviewer for another team, activity, or document submitted to the Virgo document review system).
  - Service tasks are identified in each area of the Collaboration activities, by the relevant coordinators, under the coordination of the core program committee.
  - Service tasks are expected to be shared in a fair way among Virgo groups [bylaws 3.2.1.2].

## **New Core Program Committee: Activities**

- Currently focusing on detailed definition of service task, with proposed number of SVAC (= Standard Virgo Annual Contribution), collecting input from:
  - Activities listed in the Virgo Members Database
    (e.g. items under Data Analysis recently were defined in a fine-grained fashion, with O4 in mind)
  - LVK White Papers (Operations, Observational Science, Climate Committee) and various Virgo-specific documents (instrument related, R&D, ...)
  - Coordinators and working group co-chairs

Not only "chores", but also activities (e.g. detector-related) that are fundamental

- Hope to be able to show a mature draft proposal for service tasks to VSC in June
- Next, fine-grain all Virgo activities
